In response to the master plan's objective to reposition the Stone Market to a 7 day a week market, OPA developed prototype stand to introduce high density produce sales into the center of the stone building. These stalls are to be used as an expansion of the "Garden Fresh" produce vendor into the Stone building, which has been long dominated by prepared food vendors. The introduction of high density produce stand changes the character of the building interior and is intended to drive sales to the prepared food vendors. The stalls were designed to be easily assembled from a kit of parts that will be available to future market retailers as well. Each stall can be folded up and rolled away for daily sanitation purposes as well as offering vendors increased flexibility to change or add additional stalls as needed. A fold away raised floor attached to each stall elevates vendors, allowing them to properly maintain their displays. An end unit was specially designed as a juice and coffee bar to make use of the produce sold at the stand in the form of value added refreshing beverages.
